



MINUTES OF: LEBANON CITY COUNCIL

Date: OCTOBER 9, 2012

Council of the City of Lebanon met in regular session on October 9, 2012 in the Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present; Messrs: Monroe, Norris, Rodriguez, Messer, Dearie, Mrs. Flick and Mayor Brewer. Also present was Acting City Manager, Scott Brunka, City Attorney, Mark Yurick, and Acting Clerk, Paula Hines.

The JROTC Color Guard presented the Colors and everyone said the Pledge of Allegiance. The invocation was given by Mr. Norris.

At this time Mayor Brewer asked for consideration of Council minutes for the September 25th regular meeting. Motion to adopt the minutes as submitted was made by Mr. Norris seconded by Mr. Messer. Roll call vote to adopt was unanimous in favor. Motion to adopt the October 2nd work session minutes as submitted was made by Mr. Dearie seconded by Mr. Norris. Roll call vote to adopt was as follows: Mr. Rodriguez, abstained; Mr. Messer, yes; Dr. Monroe, yes; Mayor Brewer, yes; Mrs. Flick, yes; Mr. Dearie, yes; Mr. Norris, yes.

Mayor Brewer presented Certificates of Appreciation to all the volunteers and organizations involved in the City's Adopt-A-Park program.

Jiffy Stiles and Kathy Stine thanked Council for their continued support of the Applefest event. They thanked everyone involved in the successful 30th year celebration of the festival, the weather was wonderful and the event was huge.

Ordinance No. 2012-089 An Ordinance amending Chapter 1304 of the Codified Ordinances providing for Building and Zoning Fees was read in title only by the City Attorney. This legislation will approve an amendment to Section 1304.01 of the Codified Ordinances authorizing the City Manager to approve the waiver of building permit fees for schools and other government agencies. Mr. Brunka explained the legislation. Mr. Norris seconded by Mr. Dearie made motion for this legislation to receive a first reading.

Ordinance No. 2012-090 A Supplemental Appropriation Ordinance, and declaring an emergency was read in title only by the City Attorney. This legislation will approve additional appropriation in the Indigent Drivers Fund in the amount of \$15,000 to support the services for defendants who are indigent and are ordered by the court to attend various rehabilitation programs. Mr. Brunka explained the legislation. Motion to adopt Ordinance No. 2012-090 was made by Mr. Dearie seconded by Mr. Messer. Roll call vote to adopt was unanimous in favor.

Mayor Brewer asked for the City Manager's report. Mr. Brunka advised the work session of Council would be October 16th and the next regular meeting would be October 23rd all at 7:00

p.m.

Mr. Norris elaborated on the history and importance of yesterday's (October 8th) Columbus Day holiday.

Mayor Brewer thanked everyone for coming this evening.

There being no further business to come before this Council motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mr. Norris seconded by Mr. Dearie. Roll call vote to adjourn was unanimous in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
