



MINUTES OF: LEBANON CITY COUNCIL

Date: SEPTEMBER 10, 2013

Council of the City of Lebanon met in regular session on September 10, 2013 in the Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present; Messrs: Monroe, Norris, Messer, Dearie, Rodriguez, Mrs. Flick and Mayor Brewer. Also present was City Manager, Pat Clements, City Attorney, Mark Yurick, and City Auditor, Sharee' Dick.

The JROTC Color Guard presented the Colors and everyone said the Pledge of Allegiance. The invocation was given by Mr. Norris.

At this time Mayor Brewer asked for consideration of Council minutes for the August 27th regular meeting. Motion to adopt the minutes as submitted was made by Mr. Dearie seconded by Mrs. Flick. Roll call vote to adopt was unanimous in favor.

Ordinance No. 2013-093 An Ordinance of the City of Lebanon, Ohio to amend Chapters 1131, 1132, 1133 And 1140 of the Official Zoning Code was read in title only by the City Attorney. This legislation will approve amendments to the following chapters of the Zoning Code: 1131 (Administrative Roles and Authority, 1132 (Development Review Procedures), 1133 (Zoning Districts & Use Regulations), and 1140 (Historic Preservation Standards), necessary to comply with the requirements to achieve Certified Local Government status from the Ohio Historical Society. Mr. Clements explained the legislation. Motion to adopt Ordinance No. 2013-093 was made by Mr. Rodriguez seconded by Mrs. Flick. Roll call vote to adopt was unanimous in favor.

Mayor Brewer asked for the City Manager's report. Mr. Clements advised the next work session of Council would be September 16th, the next regular Council meeting would be September 24th. He reminded everyone of the Fed X ribbon cutting ceremony on Wednesday, September 18th at noon and the Shriner's parade on Saturday, September 14th at noon.

Mr. Norris reminded everyone to think back on our nation since the 9/11 event twelve years ago tomorrow and to reflect on what we have learned as a country. He asked everyone to get involved in the future cause of liberty.

Mr. Messer also asked everyone to look to the future and work to make a difference in our mighty nation.

Mayor Brewer asked everyone to be active in making a positive difference in our world today.

There being no further business to come before this Council motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Dr. Monroe seconded by Mr. Rodriguez. Roll call vote to adjourn was unanimous in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
