Properties will be evaluated during May - October by members of the City's Shade Tree Commission, the Garden Clubs of Lebanon and a Master Gardener. Judges will use the following criteria:

1. **General Appearance & Compatibility**
2. **Design**
3. **Maintenance**

Neil Armstrong Way Connector Nears Completion

Construction nears completion for Lebanon's new roadway from the intersection of SR 123 at Franklin Road and Hart Road to the intersection of SR 63 at Main Street and Glosser Road.

The new three-lane roadway is expected to be completed later this summer, and will be dedicated with the name Neil Armstrong Way.

This roadway has been designated as SR 123 and will help alleviate existing and future roadway congestion in the downtown area.

The project costs are \$5.7 million, and the City received a \$3 million federal roadway grant in support of the project.
