### **Abstract**

This legislation will approve an additional appropriation in the Electric Fund in the amount of \$1,270,000 to support the payment of the Rate Stabilization Program payments to American Municipal Power, using Electric Fund cash reserves, in order to reduce customer rate volatility.

**3) Ordinance No. 2011-085** An Ordinance To Approve The Record Plan For The Final Plat Of Avalon Heights Being A Replat Of Lots 11 & 12 And Declaring An Emergency
